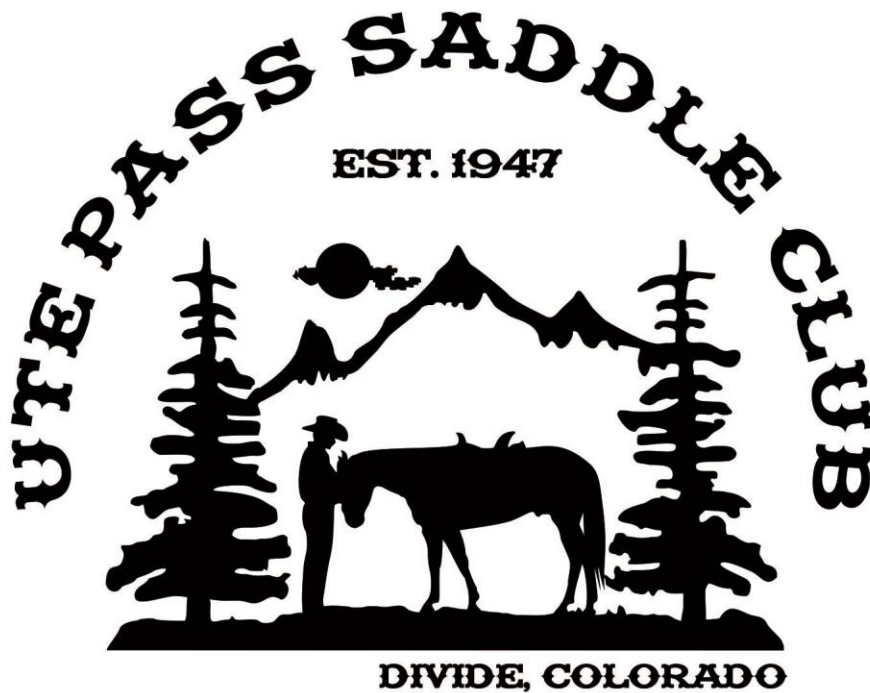

What does it mean to be Ute Pass Saddle Club Royalty?

The Royalty represents the Ute Pass Saddle Club during their reign. Not only do they promote the Ute Pass Saddle Club but the entire Ute Pass Region with appearances throughout Teller County but to visit other regions as well.

What are the duties and responsibilities of the Ute Pass Saddle Club Royalty?

Both the Queen and Princess are young women that symbolize the youth of our region who wish to further promote the Ute Pass Saddle Club, and in so doing, promote the western way of life and the ideal western-type American girl. They will represent a long tradition of the Saddle Club that has been in existence since 1947. It offers them the experience of meeting many people through their many public appearances at rodeos, fairs, parades, other community organizations and community service.

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OFFICAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Queen applicant must be at least 16 years of age and not older than 25 years of age by the competition date. She must be single and have never been married. The Princess applicant must be at least 12 years of age and not older than 15 years of age by the competition date. She must be single and have never been married.
2. Applications for the Royalty Competition must be signed by the applicant as well as a parent or legal guardian if the applicant is under 18 years of age.
3. Each applicant **MUST** have access to the use of a horse and horse trailer for any parades or rodeo appearances during their reign.
4. Each application must include a color photograph that is at least 5" x 7" of the applicant dressed in western attire.
5. The Queen and Princess must be available for appearances from early February of their first year to February of the following year.
6. Entry deadline for all application will be September 22, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. Any applications received after that time will not be accepted.
7. After all applications have been received, finalists that have been selected by the Committee for the competition will be notified by mail.
8. The final competition will be held on Saturday, September 27, 2014

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WHAT THE QUEEN AND PRINCESS WILL RECEIVE

Each will receive attire for various events that they will be involved in to include, but not limited to, a belt buckle, crown and sash.

At the completion of their reign and upon completion of all required appearances to the satisfaction of the Royalty Committee, both the Queen and Princess, will be allowed to keep the attire provided them along with their belt buckle.

Tiaras, chaps or any other Ute Pass Saddle Club apparel is required to be returned so that it can be passed on to the future Royalty Court.

Additionally, at completion end of her reign and upon completion of all required appearances to the satisfaction of the Royalty Committee, the Queen shall be eligible for an educational scholarship. This scholarship will only be paid directly to the educational institution upon verification or enrollment or will be held in trust until that time of notification.

EXPECTATION STATEMENT

As an official representative of the Ute Pass Saddle Club, I understand that I will work willing to promote the club and what it represents.

I understand that, in order to project the proper image as an official Ute Pass Saddle Club representative. I must act, speak, and dress according to the level and esteem that my title deserves at any time that I am in the public eye. My attire will be worn in the proper manner during all official appearances on behalf to the Ute Pass Saddle Club.

I understand that I cannot get married during my year commitment to the Ute Pass Saddle Club

I understand I cannot live with a significant other during my year commitment with the Ute Pass Saddle Club.

I understand that a pregnancy during my year commitment to the Ute Pass Saddle Club is cause for immediate dismissal.

I agree that, because of liability, I will not allow any other rider on my horse, except for anyone who has been authorization by the Royalty Committee, while I am making any appearance representing the Ute Pass Saddle Club.

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I agree to attend all events sponsored by the Ute Pass Saddle Club all those appearances scheduled by the Royalty Committee. Illness or family emergency are the only excuses for an absence.

I understand that, while making appearances as the Queen or Princess, I will stay at the event as long as the escort designates.

I understand that, after my introduction at any Ute Pass Saddle Club events, I will make any personal appearances that may be asked of me as an official hostess of the event, which may include but not limited to, assisting with clearing cattle from the arena or walking through the stands greeting visitors.

I understand that the only escort I will have is the escort designated by the Royalty Committee. This will include any trips that are required to be out of area. Only immediate family members may be included with me at any of my appearances, and that these immediate family members are there to support me and in no way interfere with my duties in any way.

I understand that the Royalty Committee will make the final decision on type and color choice for the official attire given to me by the Ute Pass Saddle Club.

I understand that all expenses of meals or overnight lodging while representing the Ute Pass Saddle Club will be paid by the Royalty Committee for the Royalty Court only. Transportation fuel costs of horse(s) to any official event will also be reimbursed by the Royalty Committee for only one vehicle and trailer only.

I understand that due to the demanding schedule (approximately 20 or more appearances); I will not be able to have a job that requires regular business hours. Part-time work is acceptable if it does not interfere with my obligation to promote the Ute Pass Saddle Club.

I understand that during my reign, I will not be allowed to compete for any other title that would interfere with my duties or appearances as Queen or Princess.

I understand that the Royalty Court should be perceived as a team. Therefore, the Court should remain together unless other arrangements have been made and approved by the Royalty Committee.

I understand that the use of a cellular telephone and gum chewing WILL NOT BE PERMITTED during an official appearance. Cellular phones will be placed in a place where they will not be a distraction.

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I understand that I am conduct myself as a lady at all times, whether in Queen/Princess attire or not, when representing the Ute Pass Saddle Club. This includes behaving in polite and gracious manner at all times. The Queen/Princess should never be seen arguing with any one at any time, this includes family.

I understand that swearing; vulgarity, crude remarks, smoking, chewing tobacco, illegal drug use, and drinking alcoholic beverages are inappropriate and can result in a reprimand or dismissal.

I, the competitor, understand and agree that if chosen to be a Queen/Princess, I will be required to attend etiquette as scheduled by the Royalty Committee.

I understand that if chosen, my parent or guardian (if applicable) will be required to attend training on parental roles and responsibilities as scheduled by the Royalty Committee.

I understand that my tack, no matter how new or old should be clean and show good care. This includes checking my tack often for needed repairs.

I agree to handle my horse as a horsewoman. I also understand that all training and discipline should be done at home or in lessons. If discipline is needed, I agree that it will be done in a tactful and inconspicuous manner.

I understand that in no way should I display affection with a significant other. This includes but not limited to kissing, handholding, and sitting on laps.

I understand that failure to follow the rules and regulations for the Ute Pass Saddle Club Royalty can result in any of the following: forfeiture of the title Ute Pass Saddle Club Queen/Princess, loss of any scholarship, and reimbursement to the Ute Pass Saddle Club for all of attire and any other expenses directly associated with my reign.

I understand that, if any grievance should arise during the competition or during the reign of Queen/Princess that Royalty Committee shall make any recommendation and final decision will be made by the Ute Pass Saddle Club Board of Directors.
