

WPSC ARENA RULES – Updated, June 19, 2009

1. “Arena” as used herein refers to the arena and all the land surrounds the arena.
2. All riding is at your own risk.
3. All members wishing to use the arena must have a Release and Hold Harmless signed and on file with the WPSC Office. Your release and Hold Harmless is valid until your membership renewal. All minors must have a release signed by a parent or guardian in file. No exceptions.
4. Arena use is restricted to WPSC members in good standing. Only the person or persons listed on the membership application may use the arena.
5. Guests are allowed after they have signed and filled out a “one day membership” application and paid the one day fee of \$5.00. They must turn in their application and fee prior to using the arena.
6. The arena is not available for commercial use. By members unless under a previously negotiated, specific agreement (i.e. trainers giving lessons, working colts for profit). You may receive a lesson on your own horse from a trainer. If you wish the trainer to ride your horse as a part of this lesson, the trainer must have a release and hold harmless on file with the WPSC office in advance of the lesson.
7. You must close and lock the gate after you enter and when you leave the grounds.
8. A combination lock is maintained on the arena gate. The combination will be issued to members in good standing. You may not share the combination with anyone. If it is learned that lock combination has been shared, the combination will be changed and you will lose your arena privileges for the remainder of the year. This will be strictly enforced.
9. Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times while on the arena grounds. All those under 16 present at the arena at any time must have a parent or guardian (over 18) to monitor them. The parent or guardian cannot be a rider at the time of the person under 16 is not also a rider.
10. No horse may be tied to the arena, tables, gates, buildings, etc. You may use hitching posts or tie to your own trailer.
11. The arena is available from sun up to sun set. Please avoid loud noises. No loud music or noise is permitted before 8AM.
12. Periodically the grounds may be leased or contracted to an outside group or individual. Please call the WPSC office for information or visit: <http://calendar.yahoo.com/wpsaddleclub>
13. Please report any damage to the arena to the WPSC Grounds Chairman – Myron Hendricks 748-8529.
14. All dogs must be leashed at ALL times! If at any time a dog becomes a problem you will be asked to remove or contain your dog. All horses must be on lead at all times. At no time will a horse of any age be allowed to roam freely. Exceptions to this are when using the arena alone and doing groundwork.
15. All equipment you use, barrels, poles, flags, etc. must be put away after use.
16. All manure must be cleaned up around hitching areas and trailers when you are finished using the arena. Do not clean your trailer on arena grounds.
17. You must carry your membership card or a copy of it when using the arena.
18. If at any time a WPSC Board member, Contractor or Appointed Volunteer or Official witnesses anything he/she deems unsafe, irresponsible, inconsiderate, or unacceptable, he or she has, at his or her discretion the right to require any such behavior be stopped with no questions asked whether or not it is specifically addressed in these rules.
19. Anyone violating these rules will be subject to loss of arena privileges for a period of time determined by the board.
20. Arena may be closed based on conditions.
